6" Finished Block Size Quilt

Color	Amount
*Background	1 ¾ yards
Prints	8 - Fat Eighths or 8 - ⅛ yard
Green	3 - Fat Eighths or 3 - ⅛ yard
Binding	⅓ yard
Backing	2 yards

12" Finished Block Size Quilt

Color	Amount
Background	5 yards
Prints	8 - Fat Quarters or 8 - ¼ yard
Green	4 - Fat Quarters or 4 - ¼ yard
Binding	⅔ yard
Backing	5 yards

* Background includes both Starling blocks, Stem blocks, and all finishing for the quilt. The sample was made using the Dainty Meadow Fabric collection for Moda Fabrics. Copyright 2024 @mysewquiltylife. Duplication of any kind is prohibited.

You will need the Moda Blockheads 5, Block 12 Pattern - Starling Block to complete the Flower Block.

Basic Instructions:

1. Read all instructions before you begin.
2. Use a scant ¼" seam unless otherwise noted.
3. Cutting Instructions for individual blocks can be found under each block in the pattern.
4. Check www.mysewquiltylife.com for pattern correction updates under the "Support" > "Pattern Corrections" tab. If you purchased your pattern after the correction date listed on the website, your pattern has already been updated.
5. The black arrows represent the pressing direction (→).
6. The black arrows with a number represent sewing order and pressing direction. (←1).
7. The colors represented in the diagrams may not always represent fabric color.
8. Dashed lines on the diagrams represent where to stitch.

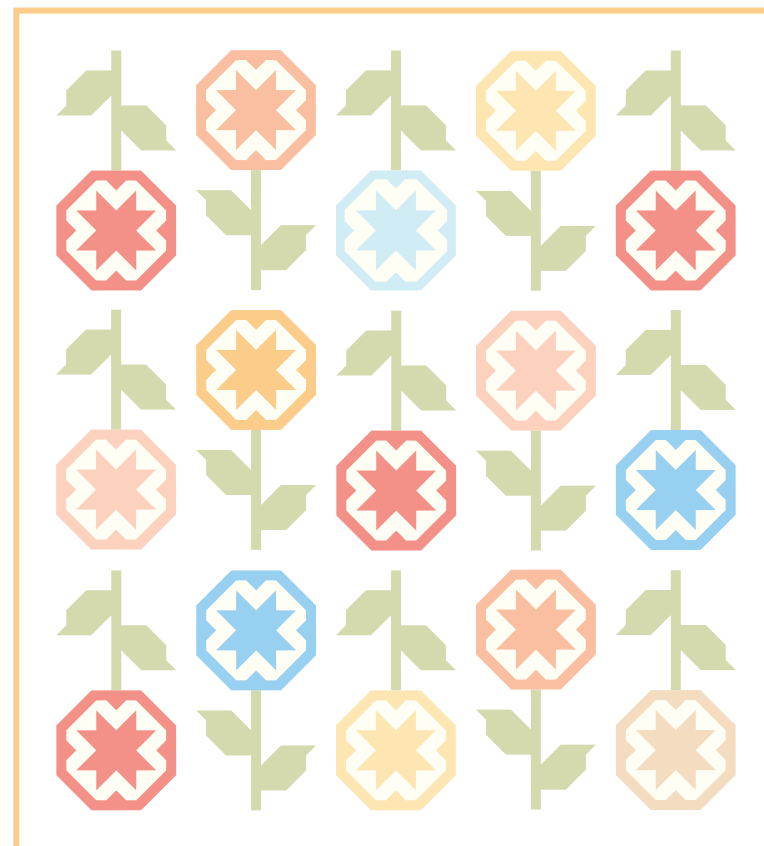

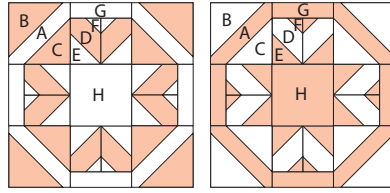

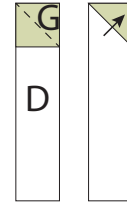


Attention!

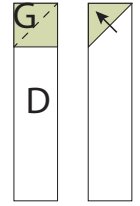
You will need the Moda Blockheads 5, Block 12 Pattern - Starling Block to complete the Flower Block. Reverse the colors to make the block look like a flower.

3. With right sides together, place (1) marked **Fabric G** square on the top corner of (1) **Fabric D** rectangle according to the diagram below. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press. The **D Units (L-D Unit and R-D Unit)** should measure: 1" x 2 3/4" or 1 1/2" x 5".

B 2 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles	30
C 4 - 1 1/2" squares	60
D 2 - 1" x 2 3/4" rectangles	30
Stem: Green	
E 2 - 2 3/4" squares	30
F 1 - 1" x 6 1/2" rectangle	15
G 2 - 1" squares	30

12" Cutting Instructions:

12" Finished Block	Quilt
Background: White	
A 2 - 6" squares	30
B 2 - 2 1/2" x 6" rectangles	30
C 4 - 2 1/2" squares	60
D 2 - 1 1/2" x 5" rectangles	30
Stem: Green	
E 2 - 5" squares	30
F 1 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle	15
G 2 - 1 1/2" squares	30

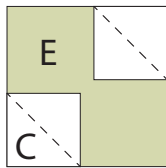
Starling Block:

Assemble 15 Starling blocks using the instructions provided by Moda Fabrics.

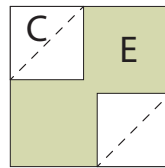
Stem Block Piecing Instructions:

1. On the back of **Fabric C** and **G** squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. You will use these marked pieces in the following steps.

2. With right sides together, place (2) marked **Fabric C** squares on the opposite corners of (1) **Fabric E** square according to the diagram below. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn lines. Press. The **E Units (L-E Unit and R-E Unit)** should measure: 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" or 5" x 5".

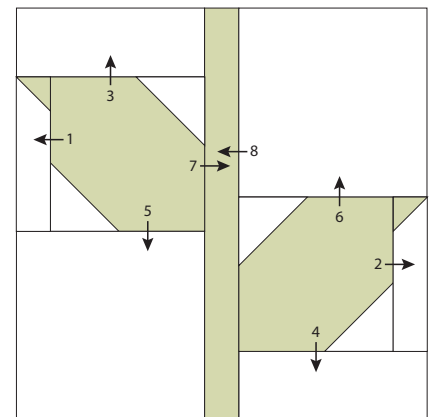
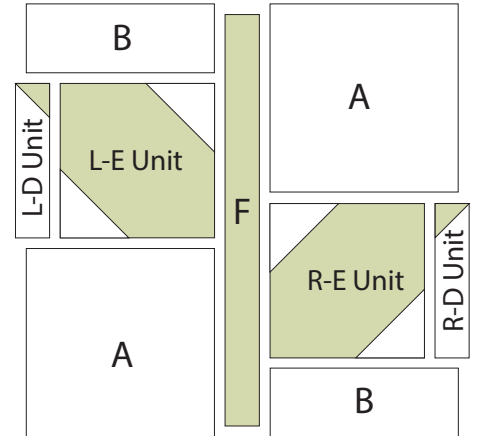

4. Assemble (2) **Fabric A** squares, (2) **Fabric B** rectangles, (1) **Fabric F** rectangle, (1) **L-D Unit**, (1) **R-D Unit**, (1) **L-E Unit**, and (1) **R-E Unit**. Press. The **Stem Block** should measure: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" or 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".



5. Repeat the previous steps to make a total of 15 **Stem Blocks** for the quilt.

I	2 - 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" rectangles
J	2 - 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" rectangles (Border)
K	2 - 2 1/2" x 38 1/2" rectangles (Border)

12" Cutting Instructions:

12" Finishing	
Background: White	
H	12 - 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" rectangles
I	2 - 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" rectangles
J	2 - 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" rectangles (Border)
K	2 - 4 1/2" x 76 1/2" rectangles (Border)



Quilt Assembly

1. Assemble the **Starling Blocks** to the top of the **Stem Blocks** according to the diagram. Press. The **Flower Block** should measure: 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" or 12 1/2" x 24 1/2".

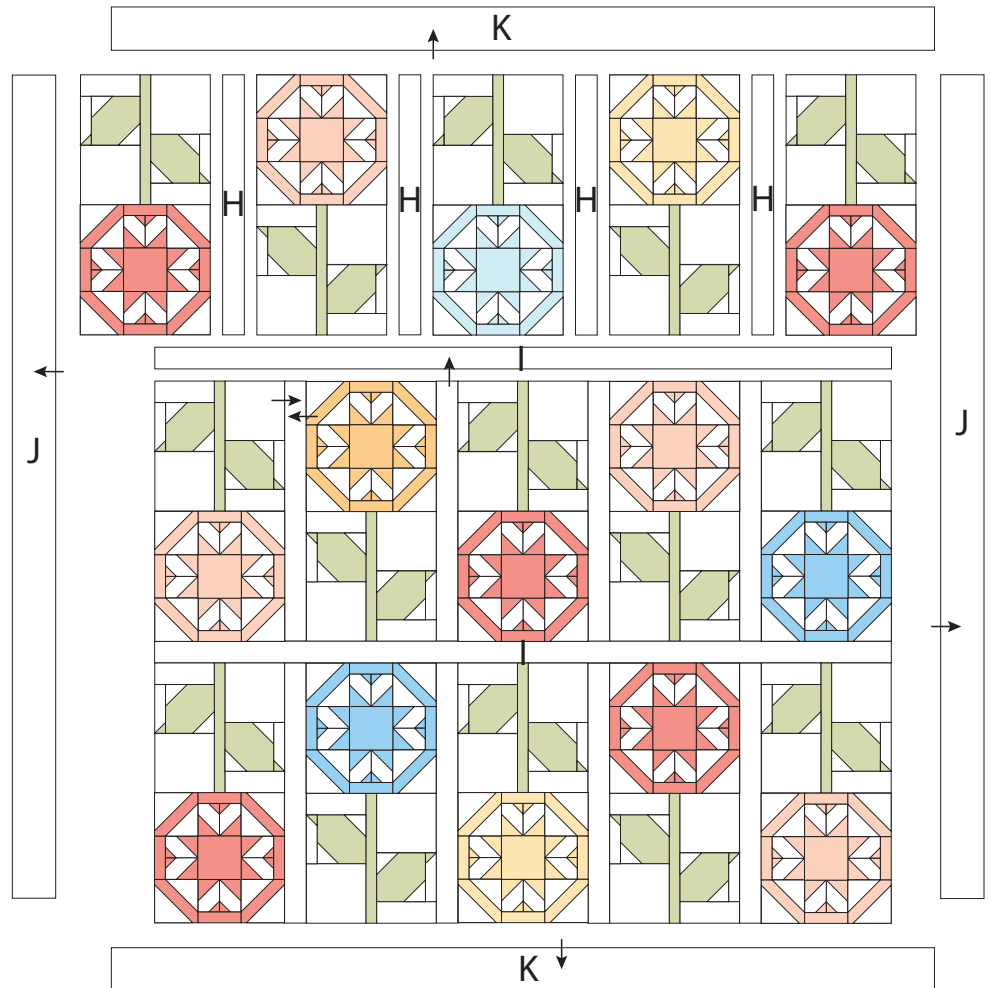
2. Assemble (4) **Fabric H** rectangles and (5) **Flower Blocks**, rotating the blocks according to the diagram. Press. Each **Block Row** should measure: 34 1/2" x 12 1/2" or 68 1/2" x 24 1/2". Make three.

3. Assemble (2) **Fabric I** rectangles to the **Block Rows**. You may need to assemble your Fabric I rectangles into strips before assembling. Press. The **Quilt Top** should measure: 34 1/2" x 38 1/2" or 68 1/2" x 76 1/2".

4. Assemble (2) **Fabric J** rectangles to the sides of the **Quilt Top**. You may need to assemble your Fabric J rectangles into strips before assembling. Press. The **Quilt Top** should measure: 38 1/2" x 38 1/2" or 76 1/2" x 76 1/2".

5. Assemble (2) **Fabric K** rectangles to the top and bottom of the **Quilt Top**. You may need to assemble your Fabric K rectangles into strips before assembling. Press. The **Quilt Top** should measure: 38 1/2" x 42 1/2" or 76 1/2" x 84 1/2".

Baste, quilt, and bind using your preferred method. I like to use 2 1/2" strips for my binding assembled with the machine method.
