



## Fabric Requirements

Color	Amount
Flower Girl Panel (Hexagon Flower Blocks)	1 Panel SKU: 31738-11
Pink (Corner Stones & Binding)	½ yard SKU: 31736-16
Low Volume (Sashing)	⅝ yard SKU: 31734-11
White (Backing)	1 ½ yards SKU: 9900-182

The pattern has instructions to make a Hexagon EPP Flower in the event the panels are no longer available. If you will be hand making the Hexagon Flowers you will need:  
Prints: 12 - ⅛ yard or 12 - Fat Eighths  
Background: 1 yard

The cover sample was made using Flower Girl by Heather Briggs of My Sew Quilty Life for Moda Fabrics. Fabric requirements are based on 42" WOF.

## Basic Instructions:

1. Read all instructions before you begin.
2. Use a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam unless otherwise noted.
3. It's best to make one test block prior to cutting all fabric.
4. Cutting Instructions for individual blocks can be found under each block in the pattern.
5. Check [www.mysewquiltylife.com](http://www.mysewquiltylife.com) for pattern correction updates under the "Support" > "Pattern Corrections" tab. If you purchased your pattern after the correction date listed on the website, your pattern has already been updated.
6. The black arrows represent the pressing direction (  $\rightarrow$  ).
7. The black arrows with a number represent sewing order and pressing direction. ( $\leftarrow 1$ ).
8. The colors represented in the diagrams may not always represent fabric color.
9. Dashed lines on the diagrams represent where to stitch.

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## Quick Cutting Guide

1. Fabric requirements are based on 42" usable Width of Fabric (WOF).
2. Cutting requirements assume non-directional fabric.

## Block Cutting Instructions:

**1 Flower Girl Panel:** (31738-11)  
Cut (12)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. See the "Cutting Flower Girl Panel" Instructions.

### Pink Yardage:

$\frac{1}{2}$  yard (31736-16)  
Cut (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Cut into:  
(20)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares [A]\_\_\_\_\_

### Low Volume Yardage:

$\frac{5}{8}$  yard (31734-11)  
Cut (2)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Cut into:  
(31)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [B]\_\_\_\_\_

**Binding:**  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard (same as cornerstones) (31736-16)

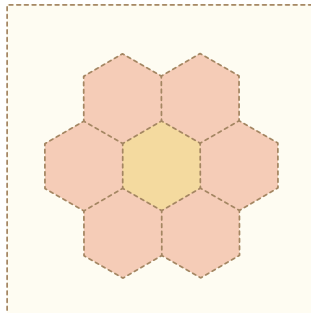
Cut (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.  
Sew strips together.

**Backing:**  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yards (9900-182)

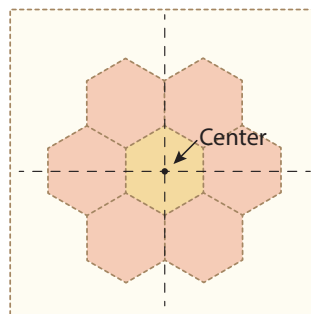
WOF x 54"

## Cutting Flower Girl Panel

1. Cut out (12) hexagon flowers on the printed brown dashed lines.



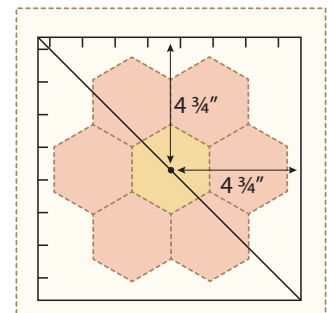
2. After cutting, find the center of the middle hexagon. See black dot on the diagram.



3. With a  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " or larger square ruler, place the  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " dash on the ruler on the center of the middle hexagon.

4. Line up your ruler with the lines of the hexagons. Make sure they have equal spacing between the edge of the ruler and the hexagons on all sides.

5. Trim hexagon flower to  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



**Cut (12) Hexagon Flower Blocks.**

Important: Due to the nature of screenprinting, some of the flowers or dashed lines may be distorted.

## Block Cutting Instructions:

### EPP Flowers:

If you are not using the Flower Girl Panel, follow the cutting instructions below:

### Background White Yardage:

1 yard (Bella Porcelain 9900-182)  
Cut (3) 9 1/2" x WOF strips. Cut into:  
(12) 9 1/2" squares

### Print Fabric:

From each 1/8 yard or Fat Eighth:  
Cut (6) 3 1/2" squares (flower petals)  
Cut (1) 3 1/2" square (flower center)

## Additional Supplies Needed:

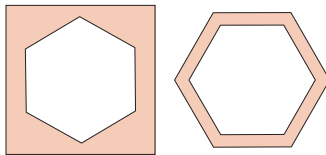
- Sewline Glue Pen or Glue Stick
- Thread
- Needle
- Scissors
- 1 1/2" hexagon paper pieces or scan and cut out the "1 1/2" Hexagon" template. You will need (7) 1 1/2" Hexagon Paper Pieces per Flower Block.



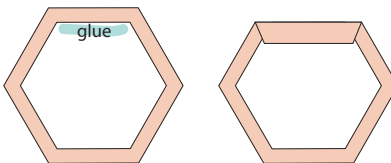
## English Paper Piecing Hexagon Flowers - Glue Method

### Glue Basting Method:

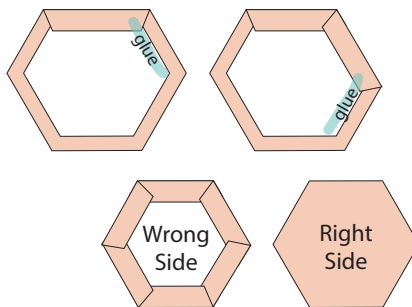
1. Center the hexagon paper piece on the wrong side of one of the 3 1/2" squares. Place one dot of glue to hold the paper lightly to the fabric. Trim the fabric square 1/4" around the hexagon edges.



2. Add a glue line to the edge of (1) hexagon side. Fold one side of the fabric over the hexagon paper piece and firmly hold for a few seconds.

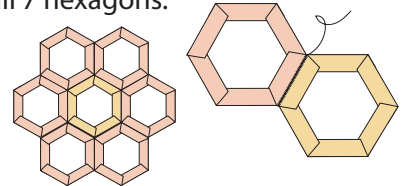


3. Continue to add glue on the edges one at a time. Fold over and glue baste each side until all sides have been glue basted.



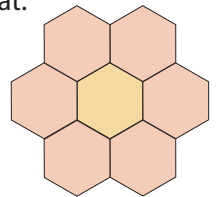
### Flower Assembly:

1. Assemble two hexagons together using a whip stitch on the wrong side of the hexagons. Start with the center hexagon. Continue to add hexagons and whip stitch on the wrong side for all 7 hexagons.

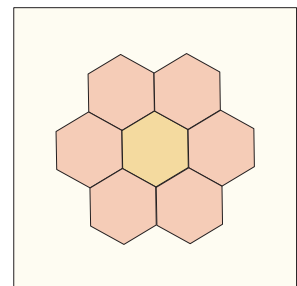


2. After you have assembled all 7 hexagons, carefully remove the papers and press so that the edges are straight and flat.

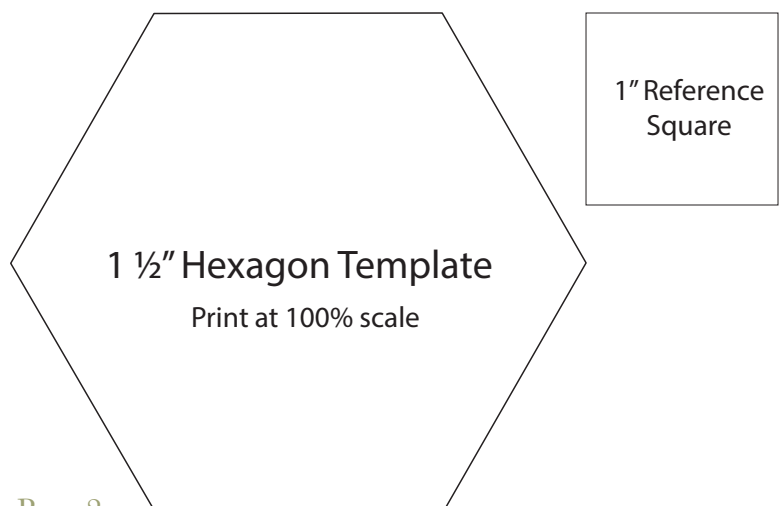
Tip: Use a needle to separate the glue on the paper piece from the fabric when removing the paper pieces.



3. Center the hexagon flower on the 9 1/2" square. Applique stitch around the perimeter of the hexagon flower. Pin the hexagon flower to the white square if needed.



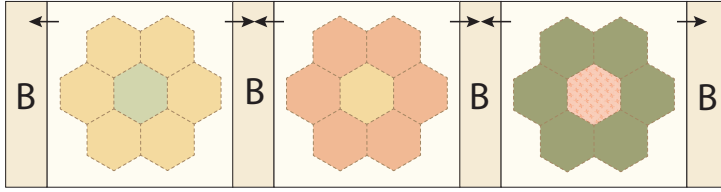
Make 12 blocks.



## Quilt Assembly

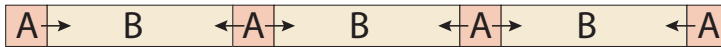
### Block Rows:

1. Assemble (3) **Hexagon Flower Blocks** and (4) **Fabric B** rectangles according to the diagram. Press. Each **Block Row** should measure:  $35\frac{1}{2}'' \times 9\frac{1}{2}''$ . Make four.



### Sashing Rows:

2. Assemble (4) **Fabric A** squares and (3) **Fabric B** rectangles according to the diagram. Press. Each **Sashing Row** should measure:  $35\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ . Make five.



### Quilt Top:

3. Assemble (4) **Block Rows** and (5) **Sashing Rows** according to the diagram. Press. The Quilt Top should measure:  $35\frac{1}{2}'' \times 46\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Baste, quilt, and bind using your preferred method.
