


Use 6 strands of embroidery floss to hand embroider the Welcome Sign.

Use 3 strands of embroidery floss to hand embroider the Tulips Sign.

FLOWER SHOP BOM HAND EMBROIDERY TEMPLATE

Get a head start and knock out the hand embroidery for all the blocks so you can jump right in to piecing the blocks.

Instructions

- 1. Rough cut your fabric for each word to the size specified in the monthly patterns under the Block Cutting Instructions or in the table below.
- 2. Use an erasable marker and trace over the words on your fabric.
- 3. Using DMC 646 floss, embroider the words using a simple embroidery running stitch using
- 3 6 strands of floss. The amount of strands is listed in each monthly pattern.
- 4. Trim each word to the "Final Cut" size specified in the monthly patterns or in the table below.

Word	Rough Cut	Final Cut
Daisies	3 ½" x 4 ½"	2 ½" x 3 ½"
Coneflowers	3 ½" x 6"	2 ½" x 5"
Tulips	3 ½" x 5 ½"	2 ½" x 5"
Welcome Sign	7 ½" x 9 ½"	6 ½" x 8 ½"
Open Sign	5" x 10 ½"	4" x 9 ½"
