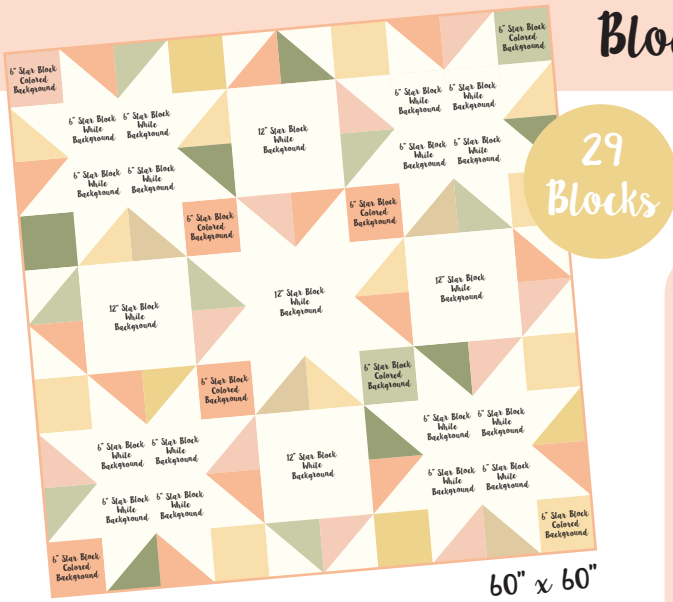

Star Dance Quilt

Showcase your favorite Blockheads 5 star blocks in two sizes, 6" and 12", in this fun Star Dance Quilt.

Fabric Requirements:

Quilt Setting:
1 yard background
A total of 1 ¼ yards of various prints.
Binding: ⅝ yard
Backing: 4 yards

Blockhead 5 Blocks:

5 - 12" white background blocks
16 - 6" white background blocks
8 - 6" colored background blocks

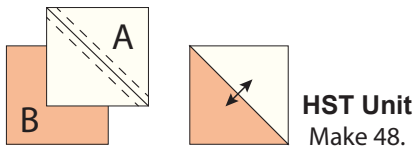
Cutting Instructions:

Background: White
24 - 7" squares [A]
Prints: Assorted Colors
24 - 7" squares [B]
8 - 6 ½" squares [C]
Binding:
7 - 2 ½" x WOF strips
Backing:
2 - 72" x WOF pieces

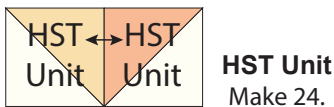
HST Unit:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all **Fabric A** squares.

2. With right sides together, place (1) marked **Fabric A** square on (1) **Fabric B** square according to the diagram. Sew ¼ away from the drawn line on both sides. Trim on the diagonal line. Press. Trim the two **HST Units** to 6 ½" x 6 ½".

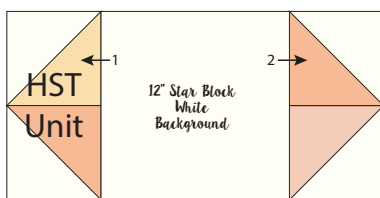


3. Assemble (2) **HST Units**. Press. The **HST Units** should measure: 12 ½" x 6 ½".



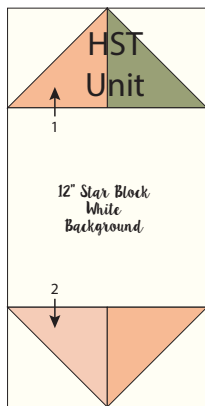
Middle Unit A & B:

1. Assemble (2) **HST Units** and (1) **12" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **Middle Unit A** should measure: 24 ½" x 12 ½".



Middle Unit A
Make two.

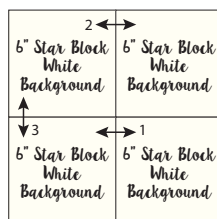
2. Assemble (2) **HST Units** and (1) **12" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **Middle Unit B** should measure: 12 ½" x 24 ½".



Middle Unit B
Make two.

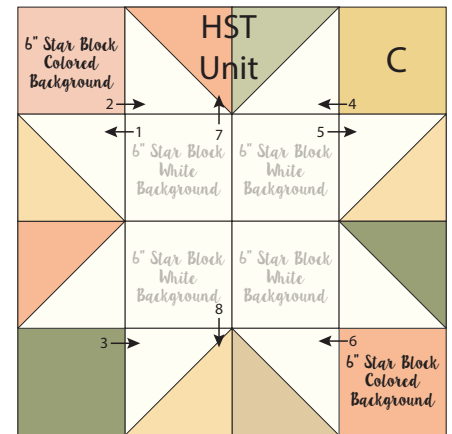
Corner Star Unit A & B:

1. Assemble (4) **6" White Background Star Blocks**. Press. The **6" Star Unit** should measure: 12 ½" x 12 ½".

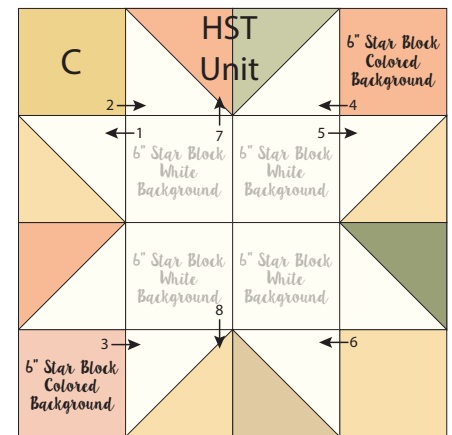


6" Star Unit
Make four.

2. Assemble (2) **Fabric C**, (4) **HST Units**, (2) **6" Colored Background Star Blocks**, and (1) **6" Star Unit**. Pay close attention to the placement. Press. The **Corner Star Unit A & B** should measure: 24 ½" x 24 ½".



Corner Star Unit A
Make two.



Corner Star Unit B
Make two.

Quilt Assembly:

Row 1:
Assemble (1) **Corner Star Unit A**, (1) **Middle Unit B**, and (1) **Corner Star Unit B** according to the diagram. Press. **Row 1** should measure: 60 1/2" x 24 1/2". Make one.

Row 2:
Assemble (2) **Middle Unit A** and (1) **12" White Background Star Block** according to the diagram. Press. **Row 2** should measure: 60 1/2" x 12 1/2". Make one.

Row 3:
Assemble (1) **Corner Star Unit B**, (1) **Middle Unit B**, and (1) **Corner Star Unit A** according to the diagram. Press. **Row 3** should measure: 60 1/2" x 24 1/2". Make one.

The quilt top should measure:
60 1/2" x 60 1/2" before quilting and binding.
Baste, quilt, and bind using your preferred method.

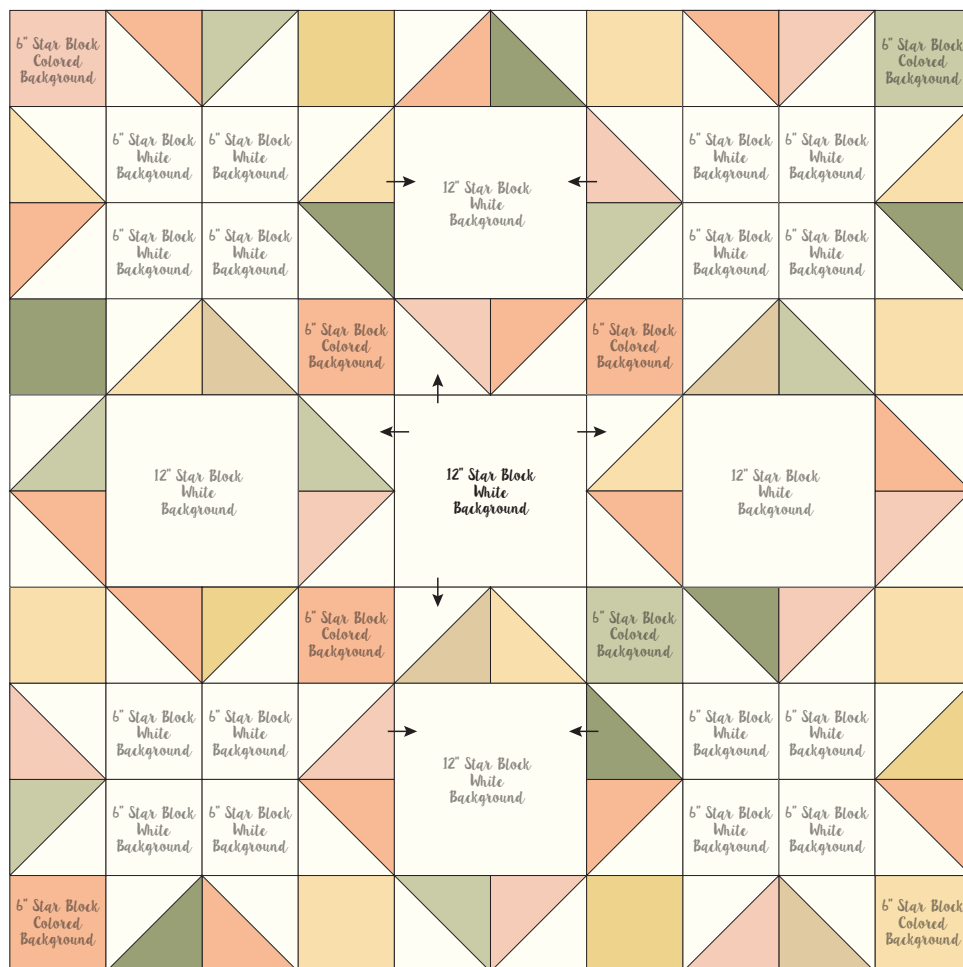

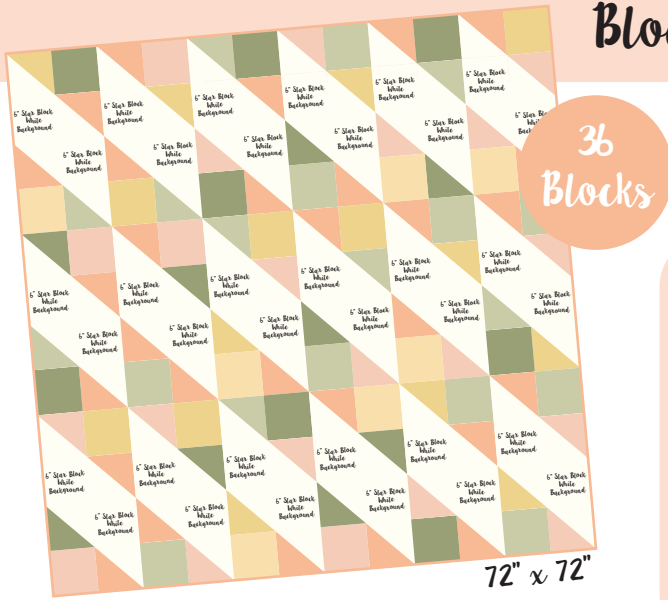

Diamond Twist Quilt
Challenge yourself and make all 6" star blocks for this Diamond Twist Quilt.

Fabric Requirements:

Quilt Setting:
1 ½ yards background
A total of 2 ½ yards of various prints.
Binding: ⅝ yard
Backing: 4 ½ yards

Cutting Instructions:

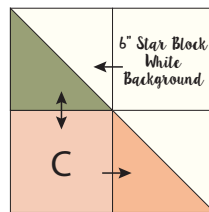
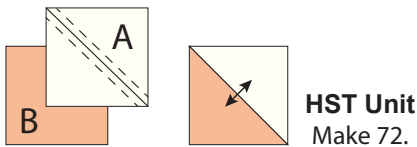
Background: White
36 - 7" squares [A]
Prints: Assorted Colors
36 - 7" squares [B]
36 - 6 ½" squares [C]
Binding:
8 - 2 ½" x WOF strips
Backing:
2 - 81" x WOF pieces

Blockhead 5 Blocks:

36 - 6" white background blocks

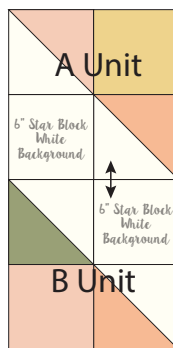
HST Unit:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all **Fabric A** squares.
2. With right sides together, place (1) marked **Fabric A** square on (1) **Fabric B** square according to the diagram. Sew ¼ away from the drawn line on both sides. Trim on the diagonal line. Press. Trim the two **HST Units** to 6 ½" x 6 ½".



B Unit
Make 18.

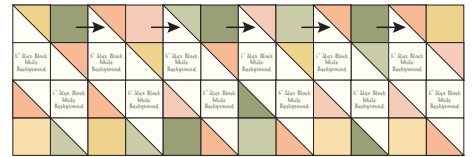
3. Assemble (1) **A Unit** and (1) **B Unit**. Press. The **Diamond Block** should measure: 12 ½" x 24 ½".



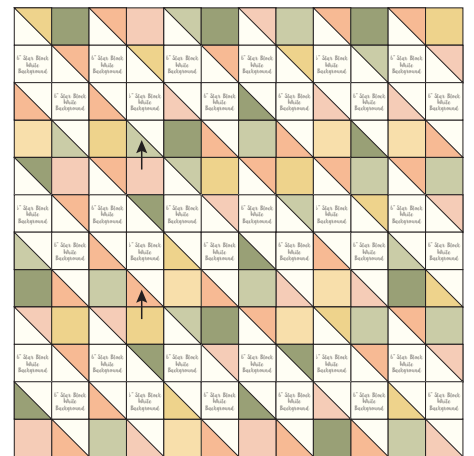
Diamond Block
Make 18.

Row 2:

2. Assemble (6) **Diamond Blocks**. Press according to the diagram below. The **Diamond Block Row** should measure: 72 ½" x 24 ½". Make one row.

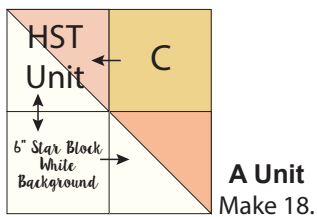


3. Assemble (3) **Diamond Block Rows**. Press according to the diagram below. The **Diamond Twist Quilt** should measure: 72 ½" x 72 ½".



Block Assembly:

1. Assemble (1) **Fabric C** square, (2) **HST Units**, and (1) **6" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **A Unit** should measure: 12 ½" x 12 ½".



A Unit
Make 18.

2. Assemble (1) **Fabric C** square, (2) **HST Units**, and (1) **6" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **B Unit** should measure: 12 ½" x 12 ½".

Quilt Assembly:

Rows 1 and 3:

1. Assemble (6) **Diamond Blocks**. Press according to the diagram below. The **Diamond Block Row** should measure: 72 ½" x 24 ½". Make two rows.

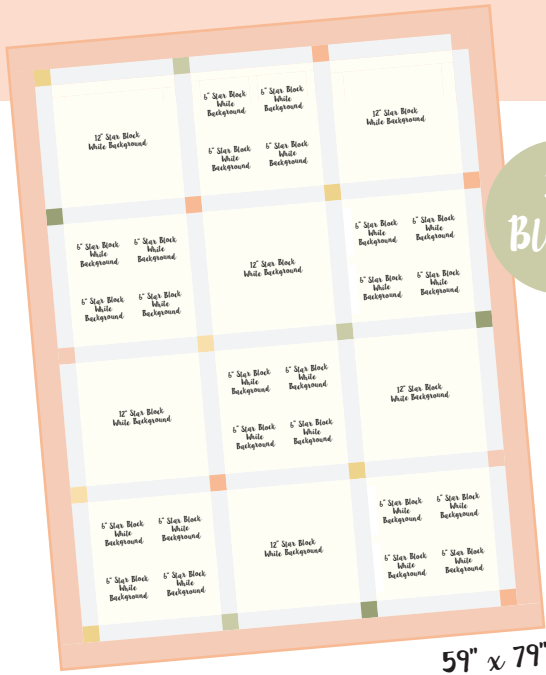

Star Struck Quilt

Show off both 6" and 12" blocks in this fun traditional setting.

Fabric Requirements:

Quilt Setting:

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards background
1 yard low volume sashing

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard border

20 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " print squares

Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard

Backing: 4 yards

Blockhead 5 Blocks:

6 - 12" white background blocks

24 - 6" white background blocks

Cutting Instructions:

Background: White

12 - 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles [A]

12 - 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles [B]

18 - 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [C]

36 - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [D]

Low Volume:

31 - 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [E]

Prints: Assorted Colors

20 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares [F]

Border:

7 - 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips, sew together:

2 - 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [G]

2 - 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles [H]

Binding:

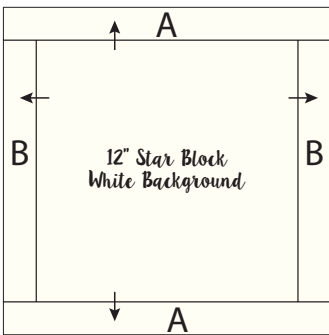
7 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips

Backing:

2 - 72" x WOF pieces

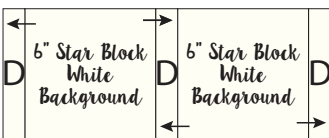
Block Assembly:

- Assemble (2) **Fabric A** rectangles, (2) **Fabric B** rectangles, and (1) **12" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **Large Block** should measure: 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



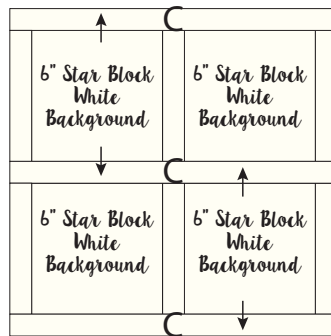
Large Block
Make 6.

- Assemble (3) **Fabric D** rectangles and (2) **6" White Background Star Block**. Press. The **Small Block Unit** should measure: 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Small Block Unit
Make 12.

- Assemble (3) **Fabric C** rectangles and (2) **Small Block Units**. Press. The **Small Block** should measure: 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

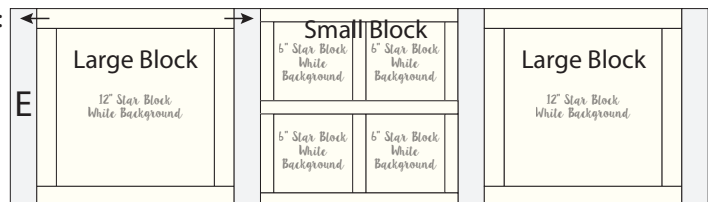


Small Block
Make 6.

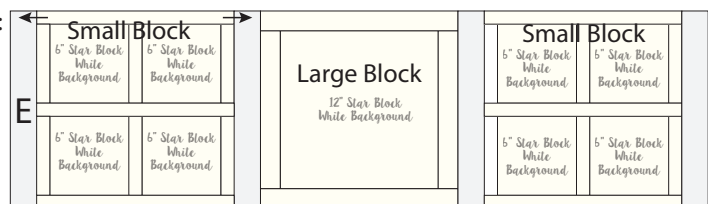
Block Rows:

- Assemble the **Small Blocks**, the **Large Blocks**, and **Fabric E** rectangles according to the diagram below. Press. Each **Block Row** should measure: 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Row 1 and 3:
Make two.

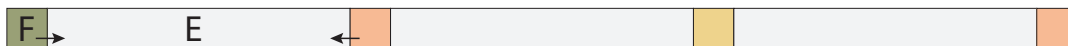


Row 2 and 4:
Make two.



Horizontal Sashing Rows:

1. Assemble (3) **Fabric E** rectangles and (4) **Fabric F** squares according to the diagram below. Press. Each **Horizontal Sashing Row** should measure: $53\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$. Make five rows.



Quilt Assembly

1. Assemble the **Horizontal Sashing Rows** to the **Block Rows** according to the diagram. Pay close attention to the placement of the Block Rows. Press. The quilt should measure $53\frac{1}{2}'' \times 70\frac{1}{2}''$.

2. Assemble the border strips:
Sew (7) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF strips together. Cut into:
(2) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 70\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles [**G**]
(2) $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 59\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles [**H**]

3. Assemble **Fabric G Borders** to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the border.

4. Assemble **Fabric H Borders** to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border.

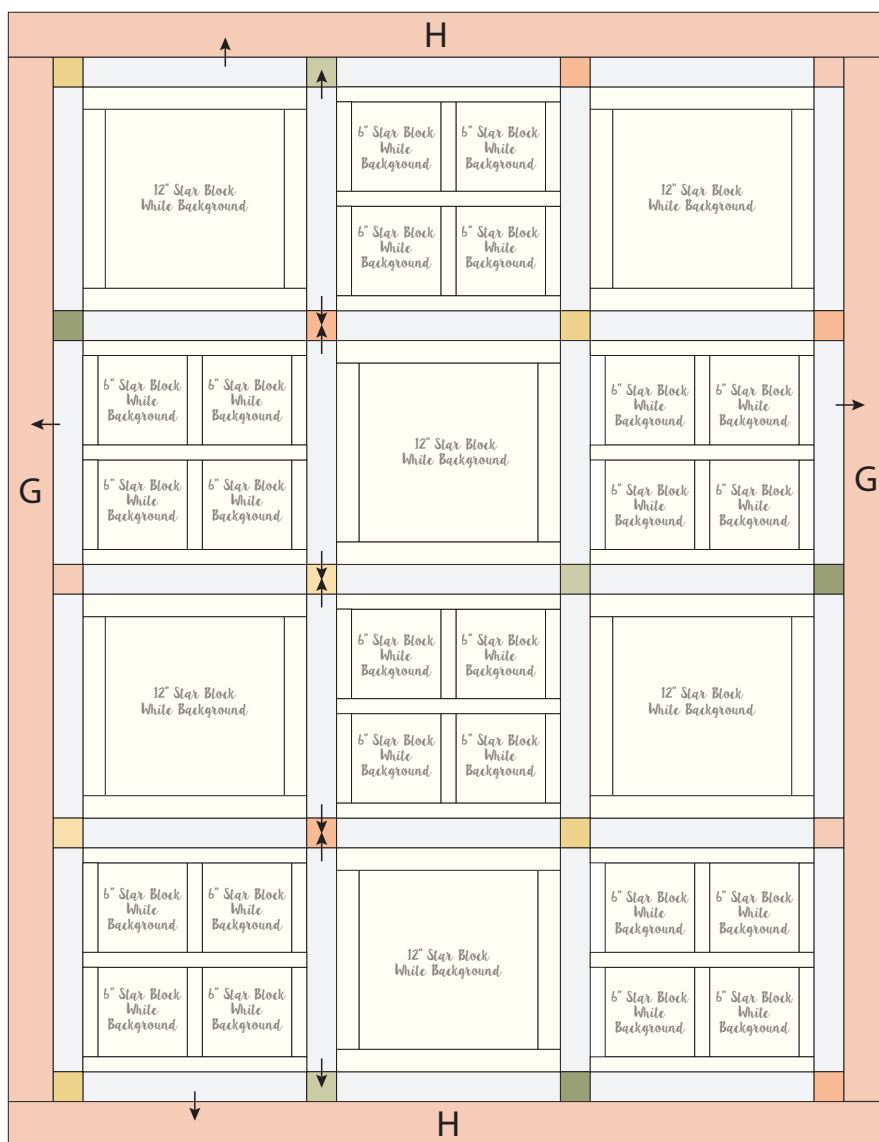
The quilt top should measure:
 $59\frac{1}{2}'' \times 76\frac{1}{2}''$ before quilting and binding. Baste, quilt, and bind using your preferred method.
