

Sunflower Stand Crib Quilt

Additional Crib Size Setting

Fabric Requirements:

Yellow (Flowers & Small Flowers)	1 Fat Quarter* or 1/4 yard	Light Grey (Border)	²/₃ yard	
Light Grey (Small Flowers)	1 -10″ Square	White (Background)	2 yards	
Dark Grey (Flower Centers)	1- 10" Square	Light Grey (Binding)	½ yard (5 - 2 ½" x WOF strips)	
Green (Stems & Leaves)	1 Fat Quarter or ¼ yard	Backing	2 ½ yards	

Additional Items: You will need The Sunflower Stand pattern MSQL #127 in order to complete this crib size quilt.

*Note: Cut the pieces carefully for the Flower Block. You will need almost the entire fabric required.



Crib Quilt 44 ¾" x 44 ¾" *You will need the Sunflower Stand pattern MSQL #127 in order to complete this crib size quilt.

Block Instructions

1. Using the piecing instructions on pages 1 through 3 of **The Sunflower Stand** pattern make (1) **Sunflower Block** and (4) **Stem Blocks**.

Finishing Instructions Cutting Instructions:

D	4 - 3 ½" x 7 ¾" rectangles

1. Cut **Fabric A** squares and **Fabric B** squares in half diagonally. You will use these pieces in the following steps.











Be sure not to stretch or distort the half squares. They are cut on the bias and could easily lose their shape.



Row Assembly

Rows One and Three:


1. Assemble (1) **Stem Block** and (2) **Fabric A** half squares. Pay close attention to the placement of the blocks. Press. Then, assemble (1) **Fabric B** half square to the top of the row according to the diagram to the right. Make two.



Row Two:

2. Assemble (2) **Fabric B** half squares, (2) **Stem Blocks**, and (1) **Sunflower Block**. Pay close attention to the placement of the blocks. Press. Make one.

- 3. Assemble **Row One**, **Row Two**, and **Row Three** pinning at the intersecting seams. Press.
- 4. Turn the quilt top to the square position and trim ¼" away from the outer seam of the Stem Blocks. See the Trimming Diagram on page 5 in the Sunflower Stand pattern. After trimming, the quilt top should measure: 38 ¾" x 38 ¾".
- 5. After trimming the quilt, "Stay Stitch" around the entire perimeter to prevent stretching and distortion while assembling the borders.



Trim excess before assembling all rows.




Border Assembly


1. On the back of **Fabric C** squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. With right sides together, place (2) **Fabric C** squares on the bottom corners of (28) **Fabric E** rectangles. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line. Press. Each **E Unit** should measure: 3 ½" x 4 ¾".



2. With right sides together, place (1) **Fabric C** square on the bottom corners of (4) **Fabric E** rectangles according to the diagrams below. Pay close attention to the placement. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line. Press. Each **E1 & E2 Unit** should measure: 3 ½" x 4 ¾".



3. With right sides together, place (1) **Fabric C** square on the bottom corners of (4) **Fabric D** rectangles according to the diagrams below. Pay close attention to the placement. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line. Press. Each **D1** & **D2 Unit** should measure: 3 ½" x 7 ¾".



Tip: When assembling the border backstitch at each seam.


4. **Top** and **Bottom Border:** Assemble (7) **E Units**, (1) **D1 Unit**, and (1) **D2 Unit**. Pay close attention to the placement of the blocks. Press. The **Top and Bottom Borders** should measure: 3 ½" x 44 ¾". Make two.



5. **Side Borders:** Assemble (7) **E Units**, (1) **E1 Unit**, and (1) **E2 Unit**. Pay close attention to the placement of the blocks. Press. The **Side Borders** should measure: 3 ½" x 38 ¾". Make two.



6. Assemble the **Side Borders** to the sides of the quilt top. Press. Then, assemble the **Top** and **Bottom Border** to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press. The quilt top should measure: 44 ¾" x 44 ¾" before quilting and binding. Baste, quilt, and bind using your preferred method.




